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Policy Statement

It is the policy of Termoncanice Primary and Nursery School that all children are dressed in an appropriate, well maintained school uniform.

Aims

- To project a sense of school identity
- To allow children to feel a sense of belonging to the school family
- To remove any sense of elitism

The uniform for each age group is listed below. Please ensure all items are labelled with pupils' names. The school strongly advises against getting your child's first name embroidered on the outside of school clothing, due to the "stranger danger" risk it poses.

Nursery:

• Plain navy or royal blue fleece joggers, white polo shirt and Termoncanice royal blue round neck sweatshirt. Logo can be either "Termoncanice Primary" or "Termoncanice Nursery"

P1 – P7:

Bottoms:

- Boys: Dark grey formal trousers. Dark socks. Black shoes only- no other footwear permitted.
- Girls: Navy skirt/pinafore/ trousers. White or navy socks / tights. Black shoes only- no other footwear permitted.

Tops:

• White polo shirt with or without logo. School sweatshirt.

or

- White shirt/blouse (preferably short sleeved in P1-3 for daily painting, gluing, etc) with royal blue tie and royal blue V-neck jumper/cardigan.
 - All children should bring a labelled coat to school every day.
 - Our active indoor and outdoor learning programme will mean children will frequently come home dirty during the week. Parents should ensure adequate uniform is purchased to maintain high standards. In exceptional circumstances, limited financial support may be available from the school's St Vincent de Paul Fund.

P1-3 PE Days:

On PE days *only* the children in P1-3 can wear navy fleece joggers (no royal blue bottoms, or sports bottoms with stripes) and simple white/black trainers – no bright colours. The children can wear shorts under their regular uniform if preferred.

P4-7 PE/Swimming Days:

On PE/swimming days the P4-7 children must wear full school uniform every day, and bring PE clothes and trainers with them in a named bag. A plain white polo shirt with navy shorts can be used for PE, or the school kit. No sports team kits are permitted.

Jewellery and accessories:

One set of small stud earrings and a watch is permitted. No other jewellery should be worn. The school accepts no responsibility for loss or theft.

Hair accessories should be small and plain, preferably in the school colours. Jo-jo Bows, flowered hairbands and other large accessories are not permitted.

Implementation and Monitoring of Uniform Policy:-

- All teachers will reinforce in their own class the wearing of the school uniform.
- Staff in general will encourage all children to wear school uniform.
- Parents will be advised it is school policy that a child representing the school on an official occasion will
 wear school uniform.
- Parents will be asked when their child enters this school to support and maintain this policy until they leave in Primary 7.
